- - Tom Emslie: ePearls
 - logging and documentation
 - moving where Pearls wants to be
 - Piloting with Ottawa Residents
 - - Desktop and PDA access
 - Personal Desktop w links, etc
 - Uses Vividesk
 - - ?Openness of the content to other groups
 - Need to understand how to input ideas into the system
- - Fred Tudiver: EBM OSCE
 - "exporting McMaster ideas to the US"
 - - OSCEs
 - used extensively in the US for formative process
 - No EBM OSCE
 - Based on work in Fresno
 - - Electronic Version
 - 30 minute station
 - 1-2 / year
 - There are 3-4 cases for the residents
 - matches a clinical OSCE
 - Strong inter-rater reliability 0.91
 - Station wired to the library / net
 - Have textbooks
 - Have to build a PICO and search for it
 - Tracks the sites, etc that the users look for
 - - Can score on efficiency
 - Can see how people move through the literature
 - Fairly Generic process and is transferable
 - Paper being written
- - Michel Labrecque - Laval
 - - Self Tutorial interactive module
 - in French
 - For residents and for CME
 - used x2 yrs
 - - important adjunct to the journal club
 - Makes the journal club more effective
 - Becoming mandatory for the Specialists as well
 - - Learning Management System / Content Management System
 - Multi-disciplinary

- Users/Content admins can build their cases online
 - - website:

 - - Pearls
 - previously the residents have done a research project / chart audit in 2nd year
 - Clinicians post questions on a board
 - Residents select the question
 - Refine the question with the clinician
 - Resident forms the PICO question and posts it
 - Follow through the EBM process
 - Post the results
 - Evaluation based on the IMPACT form
 - - Now # of residents are increasing
 - More formal process of evaluation
 - Evaluating the time needed to do the search
 - Interestingly a lot of the answers are coming from Abstracts in PubMed
 - - Do need to push the attendings to post questions
 - Surprisingly broad range of questions
- - Morgan Price:UBC E-Learning Centre Pilot
 - UBC has a distributed program
 - Residents are scattered across the province
 - The program wanted to test getting learning content out to all sites
 - - Building topics to support resident needs based on exit survey
 - Addictions
 - HIV
 - Emergency
 - Palliative Care
 - Youth Health
 - Breast Feeding
 - Research
 - Using WebCT (developed at UBC, available for free)
 - Have tried to keep as many components as standalone HTML / Flash / XML applications
 - Are currently piloting and evaluating the E-Learning Centre

 - use of EBM is increasing
